You may have seen on the news that the Coronavirus is finding its way into BC. You may be aware the Health Minister of BC has issued a statement with the federal health minister in which they make the following recommendation:

"There has been a notable transmission of COVID-19 at events, such as religious gatherings. As a result, we recommend social distancing and forgoing usual greetings. As an alternative, we recommend considering virtual online gatherings.

 - o Fever, cough, difficulty breathing
- Consider changing protocols relating to communion and passing of the peace to limit contact.
